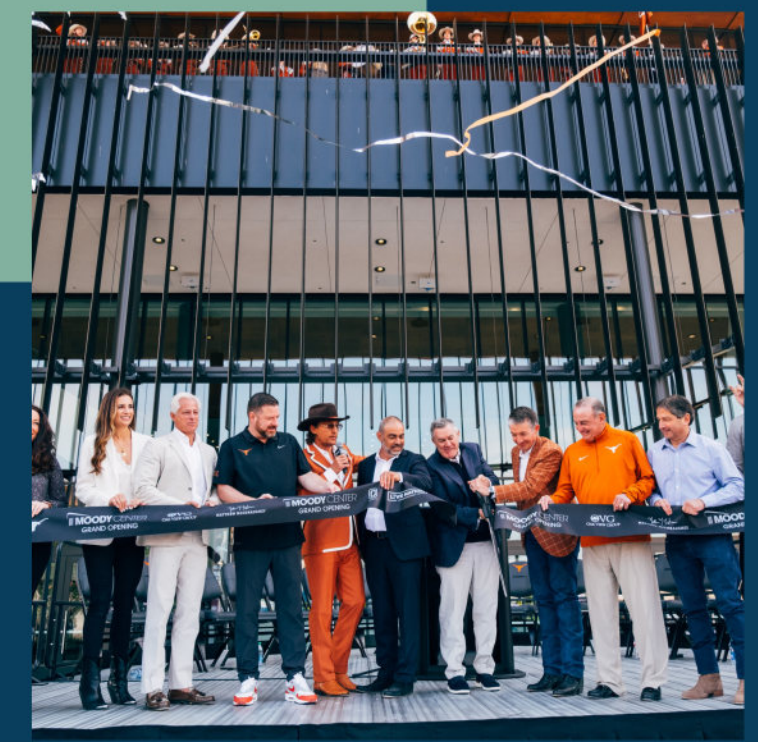
SAMPLE PROJECTS

Early Learning

- Integrating early childhood education centers within school districts
- Early identification of students needing special education services
- Replication (in whole or part) of Moody Early Childhood Center (no outreach, please)

Postsecondary Success

- Success/completion coaching and wraparound supports for first-generation students
- Support for students with disabilities during postsecondary transition
- Innovative support for the early childhood educator workforce
